Club Information

Who are the Quad City Redbirds? The Quad City Redbirds Baseball Club is an organization, formed in 2002, to provide an opportunity for kids to play highly competitive, or known to some as “travel” baseball. The Redbirds devote their time to the spirit of the game, by teaching baseball fundamentals in an environment that is intense, but fun for the kids. We are recognized as a 501(c)3 non-profit organization.

Where are the Redbirds from? The Redbirds are based in Davenport. Our players, however, come from all over the Quad City Area, including Bettendorf, Buffalo, Blue Grass, Davenport, Durant, East Moline, Eldridge, Geneseo, Moline, Muscatine, Pleasant Valley, Walcott, and Wilton.

What league do the Redbirds play in? Who do they play? Redbirds play in the Mississippi Valley Baseball League, which is an instructional league teaching kids to play with the entire rules of baseball, including leading off and pitching from the stretch. We compete against teams from the Barnstormers, Quad City Hitmen, Quad City A’s, Quad City Heat, North Scott Lightning, and Muscatine Baseball Academy among others. This league prepares our teams to participate in tournaments. Our 13U team will participate in the Sandy Koufax League.

Where are Redbirds games played? In 2007, Redbirds had home fields at Credit Island in Davenport and WBSA in Rock Island. Road games within the league are played in Davenport, Bettendorf, Rock Island, Moline, Eldridge, Pleasant Valley, East Moline, and Muscatine. The Redbirds have also played in many tournaments in the QC Area, Cedar Rapids, Des Moines, Kansas City, Omaha, Tennessee, and St. Louis.

How many teams do the Redbirds have? In 2003, we began with one team of six 8 year-olds and five 9 year-olds. In 2004, we split the group and had one team each of 9 and 10 year-olds. In 2005, we had teams at the 8, 10, and 11 year-old age levels. In 2006, we had 9, 11, and 12 year-old teams. In 2007, we will had teams at the 9, 10, 11, and 12 year-old levels. In 2008, we will field teams at the 9, 10, 11, and 13 levels.

What success have the Redbirds had in playing competitive baseball? Over the past 4 seasons, the Redbirds have compiled 24 1st place tournament finishes, 16 2nd place finishes, and 12 3rd place finishes. Our 2005 10 year-old team placed 3rd at the AAYBA World Series in St. Louis. Our 2006 9 year-old team were the USSSA State Champions. Our 2007 11U team was Iowa AA State Champions and runner-up at Nationals.

What are the Redbirds goals for 2008? All age groups will compete at the State and National level. As an organization, the Redbirds’ goal is to provide the best experience possible for its players, by instilling certain values into each player. These values are character, courage, dedication, and sportsmanship.
